1. **Ethics:**

Summarize how you apply the 4-way test in your life, your approach to decisions, your priorities and your values.

2. **Service Above Self:**

Summarize your service to others, above and beyond that which is required in class.

3. **Vocation Preparation:**

Summarize how you have prepared to succeed.

- Leadership Activities
- Scholarship (course selection, ACT score, grade point)

4. **Communication Skills:**

How you look, speak and write are a reflection of your values and standards. Your written application and interview will be used to evaluate these skills.

5. **Career or Vocational Choice:**

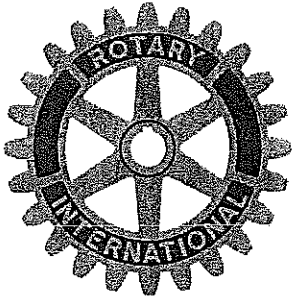
What is your field of study? Why did you select this area? What are your long term goals in this particular field?

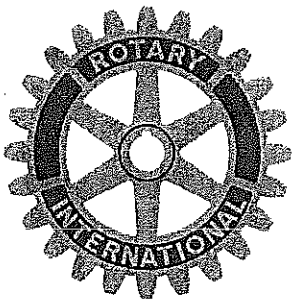

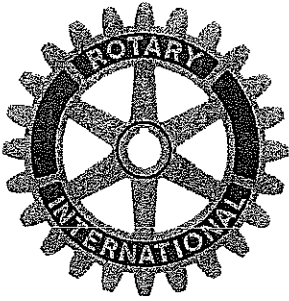
